Monsignor Frank's Message

Dear parishioners of St. Mary Star of the Sea and all visitors,

First and foremost- my personal apologies for the hurt inflicted on a number of parishioners at last Saturday evening's Mass. Several months ago the Parish Leadership Team set in place a contingency plan if more than 100 people came to a Weekend Mass during Covid Level 2. Both have made a huge contribution on the Team. Thank-you Meg. Thank-you Karyn.
