The last command given to the Apostles by Jesus was: "Go - make disciples of all nations."

AFTER COMMUNION - Will You Love Me?

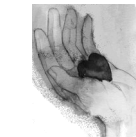
Will you give me your life forever? Will you carry my cross every day?
