Monsignor Frank's Message

Dear parishioners of St. Mary Star of the Sea and all visitors,

At the last Parish Leadership Team Meeting some feedback from our 'With Hearts Burning' programme was reflected upon. Our leaders are asking us, at the beginning of our Saturday evening and Sunday morning Masses, to reach out warmly to those sisters and brothers who are standing beside us and to welcome them with a smile and a kind word. If they are strangers, you are asked to please tell them your Christian name and to listen carefully when they tell you theirs. Later in the Mass at the Sign of Peace see if you can use their Christian Name in giving them the Sign of Peace.

We are in the process of constructing a handrail for those who are not as agile as they used to be, to come up and down from the Sanctuary in safety. It was a Health and Safety issue identified by a parishioner a few months back.
