Monsignor Frank's Message

Dear parishioners of St. Mary Star of the Sea and all visitors,

For all of us Advent heralds the start of the countdown to Christmas. As on each successive Sunday we light a further Candle on our Advent Wreath, we know that the wonderful Feast celebrating Christ's Birth is getting closer and closer. But during the first two Sundays of Advent it would probably be useful to forget about the approach of Christmas. The focus of these two Sundays is the beginning of a new Church Year. All of us will be asked to set aside time to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation during this Advent season-symbolic of a new beginning, a new commitment to the Lord Jesus.

A big Well Done to all who attended our first Charismatic Mass last Tuesday. It was superb!! We will most certainly be having another one in the not too distant future!!

Tuesday is the Feast day of St. Edmund Campion. There will be a full College Mass at 9.00am. Parishioners are more than welcome.

Saturday is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of Mary. Mass will be at 9.00am. (It will also be the 29th Anniversary of my Ordination to the Priesthood.)
