Dear parishioners of St. Mary Star of the Sea and all visitors,

On Thursday evening Bishop Steve, at a beautiful Mass, blessed and commissioned the teachers of our two Catholic Schools for the New Year; calling on them to do their best to inspire our youth to accept and live the Gospel. A group of teachers from both Schools led the music. Lots of senior students joined us from Campion College; as well as many parents and BOT members from both Schools. It was wonderfully uplifting. As a Community we are truly blessed in the quality of the Catholic character at both Campion College and St. Mary's School.

At the Mass the Bishop presented Sarah McConnochie from St. Mary's School a Diploma in Religious Education which was the result of many years of study through the Catholic Institute of Aotearoa New Zealand. Congratulations from us all Sarah.

In a recent letter Bishop Steve gave us the sad news that Fr. JeLo Maghirang has been asked by his Archbishop to return to the Philippines to take over the leadership of a Parish there. Fr. JeLo is currently the very popular Parish Priest of Morrinsville, Paeroa and Te Aroha. Our sisters and brothers there are going to be very disappointed.
