

Monsignor Frank's Message

Dear parishioners of St. Mary Star of the Sea and all visitors,

Today our Church Year comes to an end with the beautiful Feast of Christ the King. The flags resplendent in our church symbolize the coming Reign of Jesus, Our King, at the end of time... a reign of peace, justice and joy... a reign encompassing the people of all the nations of the World and of all the Angels and Saints in heaven.

Over the past Church Year (Year C) our Gospel Readings during the 34 weeks of Ordinary Time have been from the Gospel of Luke. Next week, with the 1st Sunday of Advent, the Year of Matthew (Year A) will begin. Most of our Gospel Readings for the next year will be from St. Matthew.

Last week close on 40 parishioners faithfully attended Fr. Richard Shortall's 'Advent Retreat' where, very gently, he instructed us on Meditation. It is a way of prayer which was made very popular by St. Ignatius Loyola. Participants have been encouraged to give the Lord a set time every day in order to read a scene from the Bible and then to plunge into it with the power of their imaginations. Father was very encouraging.

It has been lovely also to host in the Parish Centre the Year 7 and 8's from Campion College on their annual Retreat. So much wonderful enthusiasm! The Holy Spirit was so very evident!

Next Saturday at 10.00am Fr. Fernando Alombro will celebrate Mass for our Filipino parishioners in the Parish Church. This will be followed by lunch in the Parish Centre
