Dear parishioners of St. Mary Star of the Sea and all visitors, The year is beginning to zing along. January holidays are now becoming just a pleasant memory!

The first coming event to note is the beginning of Lent. **Ash Wednesday** is on Wednesday week- **March 6th**. There will be two Masses: 9.30am (with St. Mary's School) and 6.00pm. Campion College will have a Liturgy in the Church at 1.30pm. It is now a good time to prayerfully plan your Lent so that it will be truly enriching for you. (Fr. Jack has told me that I am giving up desserts!)

Next Sunday (March 3rd) will be our annual Parish Picnic. It will be held at the Botanical Gardens-the same place as last year- at 5.00pm. Bring a rug or a portable chair to sit on and lots of food! Games will be organised for young and old alike! Mark this down as a **MUST** on your calendars!
