Monsignor Frank's Message

Dear parishioners of St. Mary Star of the Sea and all visitors,

A letter to all Parishes in New Zealand from our Bishops arrived this morning instructing us that health professionals at the Ministry of Health have advised them that at the moment there is no need to change our liturgy practices because the virus so far is not being transmitted in the community.

The Bishops are in daily contact with the Ministry of Health seeking their advice as it relates to matters of Mass practice. The Bishops will contact parishes immediately if changes have to be made- which we will implement immediately.

Last week I spent four days in Auckland. During that time I was able to attend the episcopal ordination of Bishop Michael Gielen. It was hugely joy-filled. At the same time I was able to also attend the Vigil Mass for Monsignor Michael Browne at Mercy Parklands Chapel in Ellerslie, Auckland and the Requiem Mass on the following day at the Cathedral in Hamilton. It was such a privilege. Monsignor Michael was a special friend. He was also the Parish Priest of our own Parish, St. Mary Star of the Sea, here in Gisborne from 1981 -86. So I had a sense of representing you all. It was also a great joy for me to meet, for the first time, the 14 month old twins of my nephew Justin and his lovely wife Francesca. Leo and Louella are wonderfully full-on!

Thursday is the Feast of St. Joseph, a beloved Saint. On that day the Sacramental Programme for children, 8-10 years of age, will begin at St. Mary's School at 3.00pm. If you know of children who are not going to St. Mary's but would like to be baptised and then, a few weeks later, make their 1st Holy Communion, please pass the word to them that they will be warmly welcomed.

Congratulations to Jonathan and Chloe Reeves on the Baptism of their daughter Charlotte at St. James, Tokomaru Bay, this day by Fr. Tovio. Welcome, little one, into our Church family.

At our Saturday evening Mass, Georgina Cameron and Kevin Halverson, the two members of our RCIA programme for this year, will be formally blessed and welcomed as Catechumens. All going well they will then be received into the Church and receive Holy Communion for the first time at our Easter Vigil Liturgy in four weeks time. In receiving Kevin and Georgie as Catechumens we as a community make a commitment to remember them in prayer as they prepare for their life-changing day.
