FROM FATHER RICHARD

THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT 3 MARCH 2024

We are now on the Third Sunday of Lent. The Gospels of the last two Sundays of Lent, if we are going to look back, are interconnected.

On the First Sunday, after his Baptism, the Spirit led Jesus into the desert. He stayed there for forty days and forty nights in prayer, fasting, and was tempted by the devil. But God came to His rescue through his angels. We call this Jesus' desert experience with God.

On the Second Sunday, Jesus brought his three disciples to the top of the mountain, and there Jesus changed in appearance while praying. We call this the mountaintop experience of Jesus, in His encounter with God.

Today's Gospel is the cleansing of the temple by Jesus. The temple is a place of special encounter with God. In other words, the desert, the mountain and the temple are places of special encounter with God.

Someone once said that our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit. As Jesus cleansed the temple, we too, in this season of Lent, should be busy cleansing ourselves of our impurities and toxins. Let's start with the

little things that often add up to become big. And let's start today. Amen.


