Have a good week everyone – let's pray for one another.

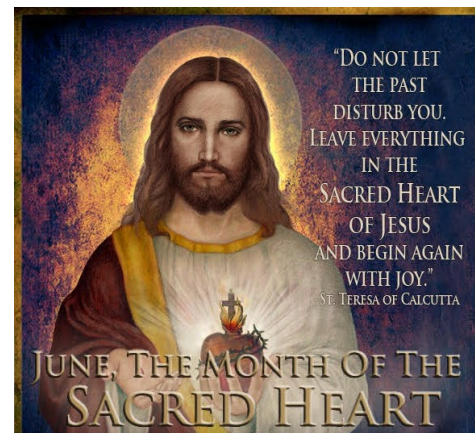
