Greetings everyone! It's good to be back. Thanks for allowing me to have some time away.

In our Gospel today, we continue to read the "**Bread of Life**" discourse from John. This series of readings reminds us of the great gift that the Eucharist is for us – may we always hunger for the heavenly bread that Jesus gives to us, and may we always be amazed at this awesome gift.

May we always hunger for peace also – this week is the anniversary of the horrific bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki. We pray that our world never see such destruction again.

Tuesday is also the feast of the **Transfiguration** – not the light of a nuclear explosion, but the light of Christ glorified. There will be Mass at 9am.

On Thursday we celebrate the **Feast of Mary of the Cross MacKillop**, such an important figure in the life of our parish and schools. As well as Mass at 9am, Campion College will have Mass at 11.30am – and St Mary's School will honour her at a special Wednesday morning Mass at 11.15am. A happy feast day to Sister Meg!

We pray for the children in the **Sacramental Programme** as they journey towards their First Communion. Our thanks also to those who lead them deeper into the life of God.

Paul Le Normand, who is the "Parish Property / Project Manager" from the Diocese, was here earlier in the week and visited all of our church properties. He will help us to prepare a 10-year maintenance schedule, particularly for St Mary, Star of the Sea. For a parish of this size, we have a large number of buildings to be maintained, which will continue to be a challenge in the future.

Some good news – Father Richard has received his **Permanent Residency** and so will be able to go to the Philippines in September to see his mother. It has been a long wait, and Father has been so patient.

There will be a further meeting on **Tuesday evening at 5.30pm** in the Parish Centre for those who might be interested in joining a Scripture Reflection group.

And **RCIA** will begin later this month – is there someone you could invite to join our faith?

So... lots happening!

In the coming week, may the Bread of Life that we share be our source for all the good that we do, and the summit of all our endeavours.
