Bishop Denis Browne died last Sunday evening, and his Requiem took place in Hamilton on Friday, followed by burial at Ohaupo Catholic Cemetery - may he rest in peace. Bishop Denis ministered in our parish as a young priest, and also gave great service as the Bishop of Hamilton for 20 years (as well as being Bishop of Rarotonga and Bishop of Auckland before that!) Bishop Denis accepted me into the seminary, ordained me deacon and priest, and always gave me great support and encouragement, so I am sad at his passing. I saw him just after Easter, and he was frail then. May the Lord welcome him home and give him the reward promised to good and faithful servants.

The **Season of Creation** continues. On this second Sunday of the Season of Creation, the Scriptures urge us not to lose hope in the face of the urgent and complex climate crisis facing us. They remind us to trust in God who is faithful and is even now working to save us.

The STAR magazine is published today - our thanks to those who make this parish publication possible. (My apologies for "jumping the gun" last Sunday.) Next Sunday is First Communion and Confirmation - while I encourage the parish to be present, some may prefer to go to Mass on Saturday evening, as it will be a full-to-overflowing church at 9am. Our best wishes to the young people in these final days of preparation. (There will not be Mass in Tokomaru Bay next Sunday.)

The Christian Life Seminars have begun - we pray the Lord's blessing on those who gather together, and we thank those who have come from Auckland to lead them. We are blessed!

I travel to Tolaga Bay immediately after the 9am Mass, so forgive me for not being around to chat after Mass.
