

### 26th Sunday of Ordinary Time - 29TH September

Springtime greetings to you all - and welcome to Daylight Saving Time! This is the final Sunday of the Season of Creation. The readings this Sunday continue to warn us that our sinfulness is destroying our communities, the human family, and Earth, the supportive and nurturing home of us all. They challenge us to be active and prophetic in working for the New Creation in these times... a big task, but not for people of faith! The Season of Creation ends on Friday with the Feast of St Francis of Assisi.

I need to inform you that both Lucy Teutenberg and Huia White have both handed me their resignations from their positions - I am grateful to them for all that they have done in the parish for more than three years. We will thank them more formally in due course. I am hoping to appoint a person as "Parish Office Administrator" (20 hours per week) to handle both the secretarial and financial roles. A job description is available from the office, and applications will close on October 18. Please pray for God's guidance during this time.

The Christian Life Seminars in our parish concluded yesterday (Saturday) - thank you to those who are taking part, and to those who facilitate these workshops. We pray the Lord's continued blessingon Roberto, Aida and those who work with them.

Nancy Smith, formerly of Tauwharepārae, died last week, aged 97. Her funeral service was held last Monday at the funeral director's chapel. Elvie Frings died also - she was only with us for a short time, at Te Wiremu House. Her funeral is in Waipukurau. May they rest in peace.

Jacob Lewis will be baptised next Saturday, and a number of children from Ruatoria will be baptised after Miha next Sunday. We pray for them also - and we thank God for their grandparents who are bringing them to faith. (No Mass in Ruatoria today.)

October is the **Month of the Rosary**, and I am hoping that we will have a parish Rosary procession at some stage.

Our Caretaker Mark will only be working Fridays for the coming month—if you see something that needs doing, feel free to help out.






